-  The Camp aims to prepare the participants to meet the LSRW Scope. (Learn/Listen, Speak, Read and Write)




DETAILS OF THE COURSE

-  The Sanskrit camp has been divided into 2 sessions.
[4 modules per session]
-  Each Module will be taught for 14 continuous days of 1 hour each per day.
-  On completion of every Segment (2 Modules) a Certificate with a Title will be issued by SCVG Vedashram.
-  The Online Classes of RAKSHA SANSKRIT CAMP will be conducted using Google Meet App.

CLASS DETAILS

-  The classes will be conducted by Highly Qualified Veda Pundits of SCVG Vedashram.
-  Classes will be taken with Audio Video aids.
-  Of the 14 days, last day will be reserved for Participants to write a simple exam for knowing their status of learning in every Module.
-  Home work will be given for Participants to practice at home.
-  Completed home work should be scanned & uploaded in respective student's folder created for this Sanskrit Camp in Google Drive.
